



CATTLEMEN'S WRITTEN TEST

The purpose of the Cattlemen's Written Test is for AJSA members to show their individual knowledge on the Shorthorn breed, the cattle industry and the beef industry.

- 1) The quiz will consist of multiple choice questions.
 - a) PI/PII - 25 questions
 - b) Intermediate - 35 questions
 - c) Senior - 45 questions
- 2) One hour will be allowed for contestants to complete this quiz. Ten-minute warnings will be given after 30 minutes have passed. Seniors in career development can compete in this contest, they will be given one hour, even if they start later.
- 3) Contestants may NOT bring notes, books, or reference materials to the quiz area.
- 4) Conferring with other contestants or the use of notes or any form of cheating will result in disqualification.
- 5) Junior Board will assist for reading words, they will not read entire tests. Contestants must be able to read tests to compete.
- 6) Contestant will be provided with writing utensils at the contest.
- 7) Each test will have 5 additional questions that are only used for breaking ties. They will not be used for the grading of the test.
- 7) Tests will NOT be returned to competitors.
